End of Year Celebration & Riding Demonstration



**36%** have used or abused drugs and alcohol prior to intake

**78%** are failing at least one core classes upon intake

**44%** do not live with either biological parent

**86%** have shown signs of depression, self-harm, or suicidal thoughts/attempts

**67%** are living in single guardian homes

**75%** are engaged in violent behavior

**25%** are court involved at intake

**86%** are victims of abuse/neglect/trauma

**53%** fall below poverty line
